During the mid- to late-1930's, a unique convergence of circumstances resulted in the creation of three Jewish-owned textile factories in Galway, Castlebar and Longford.

In addition to the contribution these hat and ribbon factories made to the perilous employment situation in the West of Ireland, the creation of these factories also saved dozens of European Jews from the Holocaust.
